Applied Music

Students must perform a jury examination at the conclusion of each two-semester sequence of applied music.

Applied lessons are required each term until degree requirements are completed.

Completion by jury of MVS 444\_ series required.

Each level of String Repertory may be taken 2 times only.

MVS 2520, MVS 3530 and MVS 4540 must be taken concurrently with MVS242\_, MVS 343\_, and MVS 444\_ respectively.

Ensembles

University Symphony or Philharmonia is required each term of residence.

A minimum of 6 ensembles must be at the 4000 level.

A minimum of 2 hours (1 hour for transfers) in Chamber Music (MUN 2460/4463) must be taken the first two Fall terms at FSU. Two additional hours must be taken in Chamber Music.

Recital Attendance

Transfers should consult an advisor concerning requirements for student recital attendance (MUS1010).

Electives

Unless previously satisfied, Oral Communication Competency must be completed as an elective.

Course Prerequisites

MUT 1112 is prerequisite to MUL 2110.

MUL 2110 and MUH 2512 are prerequisites to MUH 3211.

MUH 3211 is prerequisite to MUH 3212.

MUT 2117 and MUT 2247 are prerequisites for all advanced theory courses.
