Applied Music

Students must perform a jury examination at the conclusion of each two-semester sequence of applied music.

Applied lessons are required each term until degree requirements are completed.

Completion of MV\_232\_ series by jury required.

Ensembles

2 hours of accompanying (MUN2510/4513) are required of piano principals.

Woodwind and brass freshmen and freshmen transfers must register for MUN 2460 the first Spring and second Fall terms at FSU (string freshmen and freshmen transfers must register during first two Fall terms.) Other transfers in these areas must register for MUN 2460/4463 during first Fall term at FSU. A minimum of 2 ensembles must be 4000 level.

Recital Attendance

Transfers should consult advisor regarding the requirements for Student Recital attendance (MUS 1010).

Foreign Language

Foreign language may be taken on S/U basis for BA. Native speakers of a foreign language substitute additional 12 non-music elective hours.

Electives and Hours Requirements

12 hours upper division (3000/4000 level) music electives required.

Minimum 30 elective hours required which may include courses for a minor/double major, or certificate. At least 26 of these hours should be non-music courses.

A total of 45 hours of upper division course work is required to meet FSU graduation criteria.

At least 66 non-music hours must be completed.

Oral Communication Competency and Computer Competency must be completed to meet University requirements.

Course Prerequisites

MUT 1112 is prerequisite to MUL 2110.

MUL 2110 and MUH 2512 are prerequisites to MUH 3211.

MUH 3211 is prerequisite to MUH 3212.
